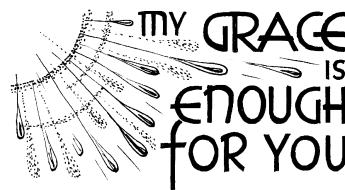

Theme— The Mass

The procession at the Preparation of the Gifts allows for popular participation in the liturgy of the Eucharist. The practice of a precession declined severely after the year 1,000 due to less frequent communion when less material was needed, and to the change in the bread used. The Church takes care of what types of bread it uses. With the advent of the small host there was an increase in the money offered and a decrease in bread and wine. The restored rite involves the presentation of ourselves and of gifts with a view towards their being transformed.
