Theme— The Alass

The title of today's feast means the showing. It originally referred to the self-disclosure of Jesus which took place at his baptism when the public side of his mission began. Later it became associated with the manifestation of Jesus the Gentiles in the persons of the wise men or Magi in the Western Church, although it retains its original baptismal character in the Orthodox Church. A third event connected with this theme is also associated with today's feast, namely, when Jesus changed water into wine at the wedding feast at Cana as the first of the signs which would show who he was.

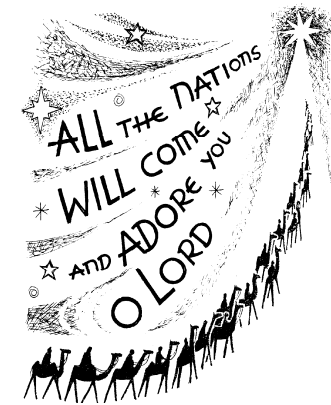
2019 Parish Calendars are now available in the Church Porch. Please take one home.
