Week 13 extract: Today we recognise that being able to forgive others implies the liberating experience of understanding and forgiving ourselves. Often our mistakes or criticism we have received from loved ones can lead to a loss of self esteem. We become distant from others, avoiding affection and fearful in our inter-personal relationships. Blaming others becomes falsely reassuring. We need to learn to pray over our past history, to accept ourselves, to learn how to live with our limitations and even to forgive ourselves in order to have this same attitude towards others.
