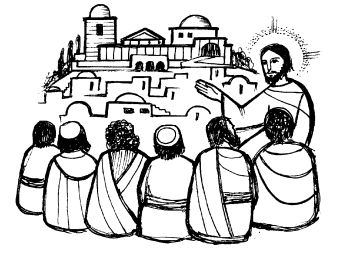


**Reflection—Ailachnamh**

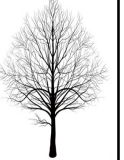
