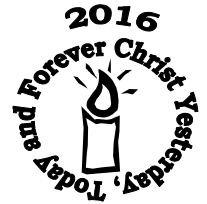

Theme— The Mass

Holy week, in the Irish language, 'The Great Week' begins today. At one end Passion Sunday and at the other the Easter Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Saturday and the Easter Vigil. Today we hear the passion story according to Luke. On Good Friday we shall hear John's account of the same event. Luke presents Jesus' passion as a confrontation with Satan, which acts as an echo of the temptation scene at the beginning of his gospel.



Reflection

Holy Thursday:

With this Mass, celebrated in the evening of the Thursday in Holy Week, the Church begins the sacred Easter Triduum and devotes itself to the remembrance of the Last Supper. At this supper on the night he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus, loving those who were his own in the world even to the end, offered his body and blood to the Father under the appearances of bread and wine, gave them to the apostles to eat and drink, then enjoined the apostles and their successors in the priesthood to offer them in turn.

Good Friday:

On this day, when 'Christ our paschal lamb was sacrificed', what had long been promised in signs and figures was at last revealed and brought to fulfilment. The true lamb replaced the symbolic lamb, and the many offerings of the past gave way to the single sacrifice of Christ.

Holy Saturday Easter Vigil:

This is the night when the Church keeps vigil, waiting for the resurrection of the Lord, and celebrates the sacraments of Christian Initiation. For the resurrection of Christ, in which he 'broke the chains of death and rose triumphant from the grave', is the foundation of our faith and hope. The full meaning of this Vigil is a waiting for the coming of the Lord.
