



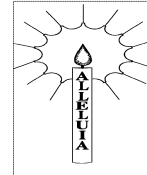

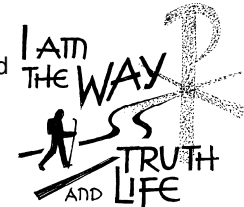

## Theme— The Mass

Jesus is our Way, our Truth and our Life, As the Gospel says, to have eternal life is to believe in him whom God has sent (*Jn 5:24; 17:3*). This is a reality for us now and it guides our life, in matters great and small. At the core of this reality is trust, that is, the capacity to entrust all that we have and are to the living God and to his Son, raised from the dead. It is not an accident that the verb "I believe" occurs no fewer than ninety-eight times in the Fourth Gospel.

### Thanksgiving after Receiving Holy Communion

Dear Jesus, I believe that You are present within my heart.
