2nd Collection: Hierarchy Commissions, THIS wknd (16 & 17) at all masses. After Vatican II, Irish Bishops saw a need to set up a number of Commissions to support the needs of the Irish Church today e.g. Catechetics, Clergy/Seminaries/Vocations, Emigrants, Lai-

ty, Pastoral, Education, Social Welfare Ecumenism, etc. All dioceses are levied for the annual costs of these Commissions & this collection is for that purpose.

Br. Stephen Buckley of the **Pallottine Fathers Missions** will speak **NEXT Wknd** (all masses), to promote their mission work. Founded in 1835 by St Vincent Pallotti. From childhood he devoted himself to the service of the poor & founded the Union of Catholic Apostolate. At that time the laity was not actively involved in the ministry of the Church & St Vincent wanted to inspire people of all walks of life to work for God's kingdom. St Vincent wanted people to treat those in need "with care & a loving concern". He died in 1850, leaving a legacy that continues to inspire people worldwide today.

NEX Sun 24th July is 'World Day For Grandparents & The Elderly'. To celebrate this day; **Knock Shrine** are holding a **Grandparents Pilgrimage**.
