Theme— The Mass

The fourth Eucharistic Prayer contains the expression 'and looking forward to his coming in glory'. It occurs at the point where what is being recalled is mentioned. It is a clear reference to the second coming of Christ and one which echoes the thoughts of the Church at this time of the year. Many prayers of the Eastern Church list the second coming at the end of the events to be commemorated, and so it is part of the mystery of Christ. In his humanity that mystery has been realised but in the rest of humanity it will only be completed at the second coming or parousia.
