Theme— The Mass

Though originally not part of the Eucharistic Prayer, the Sanctus, or 'Holy, holy, holy Lord', is sung after the preface. It contains echoes of the account of the call of the prophet Isaiah and of the vision of John in the fourth chapter of the Book of Revelation. It is a declaration of God's holiness. God's otherness. All creation is united in heaven and on earth in proclaiming this. It is a high point in the Eucharistic Prayer and this is made clear when it is sung.
