The words of the account of the institution of the Eucharist are biblical ones, in particular 'mystery' and 'eternal covenant'. Each Eucharistic Prayer has its own introduction which helps to give it its own particular emphasis or character; The fourth Eucharistic Prayer has 'When the time (literally "hour") come' and this reflects Saint John's mention of Christ's hour while at one time he shrunk from and later welcomed.
