It contains echoes of the account of the call of the prophet Isaiah and of the vision of John in the fourth chapter of the Book of Revelation. It is a declaration of God's holiness. God's otherness. All creation is united in heaven and on earth in proclaiming this. It is a high point in the Eucharistic Praver and this is made

clear when it is sung.
