IMPORTANT PARISH NOTICE

Having consulted with the Parish Finance Committee, I believe that the vacant building which once functioned as Loughwell National School should be publicly offered for sale (sale by Private Treaty) and the proceeds of the sale be held in Trust, in keeping with the Catholic ethos of the four existing national schools in Moycullen parish. The trust fund would be divided pro-rata between the schools on the basis of student population for the current school year. Funds could then be drawn-down by making an application to the Parish Finance Committee.

If anyone has a viable and alternative plan for the use of said site, they are welcome to share their views in writing with Fr Martin Whelan through the parish office. Due consideration will be given to all suggestions before a final decision is made.
