### Theme— The Mass

A feature of the Eucharistic Prayers we us is the mention of the word 'memorial', immediately after the words of institution, when the essential moments of the Paschal Mystery are recalled. There is a direct link to the words in institution, to the command of the Lord who said: 'Do this in memory of me.' This memorial sometimes referred to as the anamnesis is an essential element of every Eucharistic Prayer. No Eucharistic Prayer confines itself to remembering the death of Christ but it is always the death and resurrection, in other words, the Paschal Mystery, which is called to mind.
