Since 1969 the first Sunday after Christmas has been kept as the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, a devotion which greatly increased in the popular imagination in the Seventeenth Century. The scriptures and the liturgy give very little emphasis to the private life of Jesus, dominated as they both are with his public ministry. Today's feast is an exception. The details of their family life are lost. The significance enduring.
