



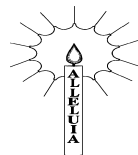

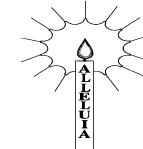

## Mass Theme - Téama Aifrinne

Simon Peter the fisherman from Bethsaida was chosen by the Lord to lead the community of believers after Jesus' ascension. He himself had to learn what it meant to be a follower of Jesus and the accounts of him in the Gospels are for from glowing at times. His is a reflection of struggling with failure a that is part of discipleship. St Paul of Tarsus, who's dramatic call by the Lord is found in the Acts of the Apostles, thought not one of the Twelve, is the Apostle of the gentiles. The celebration of their common feast day is a symbol of the inclusive call of God in both Jew and gentile alike.
