



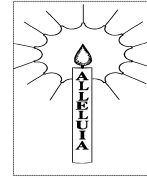

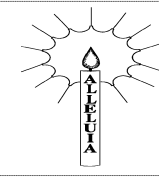

bread") and by sharing our faith ("they told their

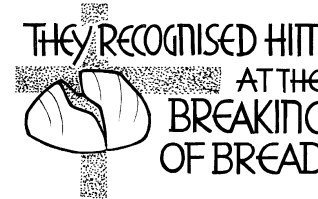
story"). Is there more? As the story starts, he stops
