The prayer found at the end of today's first reading is known in Hebrew as the Shema, from the first word which means 'hear'. It is a prayer which is very dear to the heart of the Jewish community and each Jew is urged to recite this prayer three times each day: in the morning, during the day and in the evening. Also it is the prayer which the Jews hope will be on their lips in their dying moments. When so many Jews were sent to their deaths during the Holocaust it must have been recited by those who could bring themselves to think of God under such circumstances.
